The mission of the Los Angeles Center for Law and Justice (LACLJ) is to secure justice for survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault and empower them to create their own futures. Since 1973, LACLJ has provided legal services to communities that face multiple barriers to accessing justice.

About 80% of family law cases involve at least one self-represented person largely because they cannot afford an attorney. In LA County, this statistic is representative of over 16,000 survivors! Without access to legal representation, survivors can lose restraining order protection, custody of their children, and their visitation rights as a parent.

LACLJ provides survivors with an expert attorney and a dedicated advocate in and outside of the courtroom. We not only help to address survivors' legal battles, but also connect families to the resources they need to build self-sufficiency and create more hopeful futures.

## Who We Serve

100% are Low-income  
80% are Latino/Hispanic  
83% are Women  
72% are Immigrants  
63% have Children

## Impact

At the close of services, LACLJ clients overwhelmingly indicate they have **less fear** and depression, have **better relationships** with their children, and are **more closely connected to loved ones and community**.



### Domestic Violence

To protect the safety of survivors and their children, attorneys help survivors obtain favorable restraining and custody orders.

### Sexual Assault

Attorneys help survivors navigate the criminal justice system and understand their rights so they can be empowered in court.

### Immigration Relief

Attorneys help families pursue survivor-based immigration relief so they can start their path to legal status and financial stability.

### Supportive Services

Social workers assist survivors with safety planning and linkages to other community resources that support their well-being.

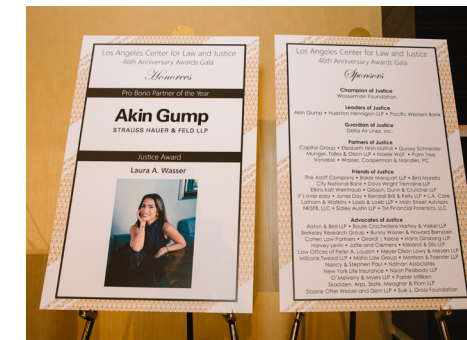
